

The Board of Directors of the Central Lee Community School District met in special session on Monday, June 12th, 2017, with Bob Galle, Mark Hulsebus and Verna Brunstein present to answer roll call. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Motion by Brunstein to approve the agenda, seconded by Hulsebus, motion carried unanimously.

Superintendent Crozier recommended a 2.01% total package increase for all non-certified and administrators. He received one written request from Computer Building Technician Kyle Van Ausdall requesting that his hourly wage of \$20.00 be increased to \$25.00 per hour. He stated that Mr. Van Ausdall's hourly wage hasn't been raised since he was hired for this position. Superintendent Crozier recommended \$23.00 per hour plus an additional 2.01% for next year. Hulsebus asked, if this was missed. Superintendent Crozier responded he is paid hourly, and it is hard to disagree with an increase due to the fact that he is here all summer. Galle responded that you couldn't hire anyone less than \$25.00 an hour off the street.

Superintendent Crozier informed the board that he was moving Gary Steffensmeier to a 1.0 FTE and he will be teaching one high school high level math class. He will take over Hollie Weber's AP students for two blocks each day at the high school.

Motion by Hulsebus to approve the 2.01% total package increase for all non-certified employees and administrators, as well as increasing Computer Building Technician Kyle Van Ausdall to \$23.00 per hour plus a 2.01% increase for FY2017-2018, seconded by Brunstein, motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Hulsebus to adjourn, seconded by Brunstein, motion carried unanimously. The meeting closed at 6:09 p.m.
